- Adopt participatory teaching approach in the classroom to help students develop reflective thinking ar-(v) critical questioning skills. Students shall maintain continuing and comprehensive evaluation reporobservation records and reflective journals, which provide opportunities for reflective thinking.

4.3 Assessment

For each theory course, at least 20% to 30% marks may be assigned for continuous internal assessment and 70%to 80% for examination conducted by the examining body, and one-fourth of the total marks shall be allocated to evaluating the students' performance during the 16 weeks of school internship. The weightage for internal and external assessment shall be fixed by the affiliating body within the ranges specified above Candidates must be internally assessed on the entire practicum course and not only on the project/field work given to them as part of their units of study. The basis for assessment and criteria used ought to be transparent for students to benefit maximally out of professional feedback. Students shall be given information about their grades marks as part of professional feedback so that they get the opportunity to improve their performance. The bases of internal assessment may include individual or group assignments, observation records, diaries, reflective journal, etc. Staff
